Excluded from the number of filings and terminations in the Courts of Appeal are the cases assigned by the Supreme Court to the Intermediate Court of Appeals, and the cases transferred from the Intermediate Court of Appeals to the Supreme Court.

Primary Cases are original cases filed in the Office of the Chief Clerk of the Supreme Court. Appeals and original proceedings are classified as primary cases.

Supplemental Proceedings arise out of primary cases. During the fiscal year, of the 2,965 supplemental proceedings filed, 2,770 were filed in the Supreme Court, and 195 were filed in the Intermediate Court of Appeals.
