ORDER AMENDING RULES 6 AND 7  
OF THE HAWAI'I CIVIL TRAFFIC RULES

(By: Moon, C.J.; Levinson, Nakayama, Acoba, and Duffy, JJ.)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rules 6 and 7 of the Hawai'i Civil Traffic Rules are amended as follows, effective March 31, 2005, (deleted material is bracketed and stricken, new material is underlined):

1. Rule 6 is amended as follows:

**RULE 6. COMMENCEMENT OF ACTION**

An action is commenced by serving the notice of traffic infraction [~~and by filing it with the Traffic Violations Bureau or District Court of the circuit where the alleged traffic infraction occurred~~] on the driver of a motor vehicle, or in the case of a traffic infraction involving parking, by affixing the notice conspicuously to the vehicle.

2. Rule 7 is amended as follows:

**RULE 7. FILING THE COMPLAINT**

The officer or some other person authorized by the issuing entity shall file the original of the notice of traffic infraction with, or transmit an electronic copy of the notice of traffic infraction to, the Traffic Violations Bureau or District


Court of the circuit where the alleged traffic infraction occurred, no later than seven (7) working days after the date [it] the notice is issued.
