


ORDER EXTENDING EFFECTIVE DATE OF RULES 5(b)(1), 7(a), 7(d), 7(h) and FORM D OF THE HAWAI'I RULES OF PENAL PROCEDURE  
(By: Moon, C.J., Levinson, Nakayama, Acoba, and Duffy, JJ.)

Upon consideration of District Court Judge Colette Garibaldi's request to extend the effective date of those portions of our November 4, 2005 order amending Rules 5(b)(1), 7(a), 7(d), 7(e), 7(h), and Form D of the Hawai'i Rules of Penal Procedure that require written criminal complaints in lieu of oral charging,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the effective date of our November 4, 2005, order amending Rules 5(b)(1), 7(a), 7(d), 7(e), 7(h), and Form D of the Hawai'i Rules of Penal Procedure is extended to July 1, 2008, except for the amendment to Rule 7(e) therein, which was effective January 1, 2006.
