ORDER REPEALING AND RESERVING
HAWAI'I RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE FORM 5
(By: Moon, C.J., Nakayama, Acoba, and Duffy, JJ., and
Intermediate Court of Appeals Chief Judge Recktenwald,
assigned by reason of vacancy)

Upon review of the Hawai'i Rules of Appellate Procedure (HRAP), it appears that HRAP Rule 36 was amended by order filed June 20, 2006 to remove the requirement that a party prepare the notice and judgment on appeal, making HRAP Form 5 superfluous. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Hawai'i Rules of Appellate Procedure Form 5 is repealed and the Form number is reserved, effective immediately.
