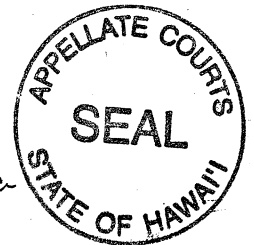
ORDER EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
