IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 14.1 of the Hawai'i
Rules for Certification of Spoken and Sign Language Interpreters,
is amended, effective July 1, 2012, as follows (deleted material
is bracketed and stricken; new material is underscored):

Rule 14. APPOINTMENT OF COURT INTERPRETER

14.1 Court interpreters shall be appointed in accordance with the rules of court. When making an appointment, a court [may] should give preference to court interpreters within that circuit who have been qualified under these Rules for Certification of Spoken and Sign Language Interpreters in Hawai'i State Courts. A court interpreter who has been qualified under these


rules shall be paid in accordance with the interpreter's designation. *See* Appendix A.
