NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO EXEMPTION

Pursuant to HRS § 103D -102 (b)(4) and HAR Chapter 3-120, The Judiciary requests to amend an exemption for the following:

Describe the goods, services or construction: Req# 2996 - Extension of IBM Mainframe Z9 system IGF straight lease for Hardware Maintenance and Software, Operating System, Middleware and Z/VM Software Support currently on a month to month lease. Under Contract No.J08160 we request execution of a 4th Amendment to Agreement, extending the contract from February 1, 2014 to June 30, 2014. This will allow time for Judiciary to complete a cooperative purchase with ICSD and formal solicitation within the coming months for a new price list for leasing new mainframe equipment, or to do our own solicitation for other equipment to replace the current mainframe equipment.</p>	
<p>2. Vendor/Contractor/Service Provider: SIRIUS Computer Solutions, Inc (Subcontractor IBM Corporation)</p>	<p>3. Amount of Request: \$196,807.80</p>
<p>4. Term of Contract From: To: 02/01/2014 06/30/2014</p>	<p>5. Prior Judiciary Procurement Exemption No. (if applicable): JE13-32 JAE13-08</p>
<p>6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: SIRIUS and IBM are the only vendors that have full knowledge of the current mainframe's architecture, software, hardware and configuration environment. SIRIUS currently supports our mainframe software. IBM is the subcontractor that supports the mainframe hardware. The Judiciary's current mainframe lease and maintenance are through this JUD Contract No. J08160 with Sirius - Third Amendment to Agreement. With all this prior knowledge and lease documentation, it would not be practicable to change vendor at this time. This month to month lease must be extended through Sirius and its sub IBM until such time the above mentioned solicitations are completed.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Due to Sirius and IBM's current involvement as the contractors that installed the current Z9 system in 2008 and providing services as our current maintenance contractors; Sirius and IBM already possesses the skills and knowledge background for the Judiciary mainframe Z9 system.</p>
