 3. Service shall be considered complete thirty (30) days after the date of mailing. By law, the Defendant has an additional twenty (20) days after that date to file an *Answer to Complaint for Divorce*.
 4. Plaintiff shall attest to the fact of mailing and the date thereof by affidavit, attaching the sender's receipt for that mail and, if available, the return receipt and envelope.
 5. **Court Hearing: No sooner than fifty (50) days after these documents are mailed to the Defendant, Plaintiff shall submit all necessary documents (including the (proposed *Divorce Decree* and *Certificate of Divorce*), *Plaintiff's Affidavit of Mailing in Lieu of Publication* and a copy of the *Declaration of Posting* to this Court for the setting of a court hearing on this matter.**
