

How to Download Oral Argument Audio Files to Your Computer


Navigate to the Oral Argument [Audio Recordings Archive](#) link. Click on the case number of the Oral Argument that you wish to download. You will be taken to the page where the mp3 file is located (see picture below).

Step 2: Right Click on the **“Listen to the entire audio recording in mp3 format”** link.

The picture below shows that the mp3 file will be downloaded to the users desktop. CLICK “Save Target as” the SAVE button to download the file (see graphic below).
