## NOTICE OF PETITION FOR RETENTION THE HONORABLE MICHAEL K. TANIGAWA

The Judicial Selection Commission, State of Hawai'i, announces that the term of the **Honorable Michael K. Tanigawa** as a District Judge, District Court of the First Circuit (island of O'ahu), State of Hawai'i, will expire on **August 25, 2016**. Judge Tanigawa, in accordance with Section 3, Article VI of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, has petitioned to be retained in office and to be renewed for an additional term. The Constitution of the State of Hawai'i empowers the Commission to determine whether Judge Tanigawa should be retained in office for an additional term of six years.
