Upon review of the record, it appears that:

(1) Defendant-Appellant Roger Bryner (Appellant) filed a notice of appeal on December 22, 2009; (2) on February 22, 2010, the appellate clerk filed a notice of entering case on calendar and notified Appellant the jurisdictional statement was due on March 4, 2010 and the opening brief was due on April 3, 2010; (3) Appellant did not file the statement of jurisdiction or the opening brief; (4) on April 9, 2010, the appellate clerk informed Appellant that (a) the time to file the statement of jurisdiction and the opening brief expired; (b) the matter would be brought to the attention of the court on April 16, 2010 for such action as the court deems proper; and (c) the appeal may be dismissed pursuant to HRAP Rule 30; and (5) Appellant did not file the statement of jurisdiction and opening brief or seek relief from default. 

pursuant to HRAP Rule 30.


