Upon review of the record, it appears that:

(1) on May 19, 2011, Defendant-Appellant Russell K. Kahookele (Appellant) filed a notice of appeal; (2) the record on appeal was filed on July 18, 2011, and the appellate clerk informed Appellant that the jurisdictional statement was due on July 28, 2011 and the opening brief was due on August 29, 2011; (3) Appellant did not file either document; (4) on November 4, 2011, the appellate clerk provided notice to Appellant that:
