ORDER DESIGNATING DISTRICT JUDGES OF THE FIRST,

SECOND, THIRD, AND FIFTH JUDICIAL CIRCUITS,

OF THE STATE OF HAWAI'I TO ACT AS DISTRICT FAMILY

JUDGES IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CIRCUIT

Pursuant to section 571-8(b) of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes, I, RONALD T. Y. MOON, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby designate the several district judges of the District Courts of the First, Second, Third, and Fifth Judicial Circuits to act as district family judges in their respective circuits, on an as needed basis, to hear such family court matters as shall be assigned to them by the Senior Family Judge of that circuit, who shall coordinate such assignments with the Administrative Judge of the District Court of that circuit; provided that all acting district family judges shall also hear such district court matters as may be assigned to them by their respective administrative judge. This designation shall be effective upon the filing of this order and shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered.

This designation shall also apply to any judge who may hereinafter be appointed and qualified as a district judge of the First, Second, Third, or Fifth Judicial Circuit and shall be effective immediately upon his or her signing of the oath of office.
