### MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT AVAILABLE TO COURT INTERPRETERS Effective Date: JULY 1, 2007

## WHO CAN CLAIM MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT? HOW MUCH CAN I CLAIM?

Under the Hawai'i State Judiciary's new Court Interpreter Certification Program
and related payment guidelines, court interpreters may claim reimbursement for
mileage expenses at a rate of \$0.35 per mile for the actual miles traveled to and
from the interpreter's home address and interpreting assignment site(s).

#### HOW DO I CLAIM MY REIMBURSEMENT?

- Claims must be included on the "Invoice for Interpreting Services" form and timely submitted to the proper Court for processing.
- Mileage reimbursement claims will ONLY be processed if a PHYSICAL home address is recorded with the Judiciary's Office on Equality and Access to the Courts.

# WHAT DO I DO IF THE OFFICE ON EQUALITY AND ACCESS TO THE COURTS DOES NOT HAVE MY PHYSICAL HOME ADDRESS ON FILE?

If you will be claiming mileage reimbursement and do not currently have a
physical home address on file with the Office on Equality and Access to the
Courts, you MUST submit a signed, written letter providing a physical home
address, by mail or hand-delivery, to:
