The Judicial Selection Commission, State of Hawai'i, announces that the term of the **Honorable Melanie Mito May** as District Judge of the District Court of the First Circuit, State of Hawai'i, will expire on **June 22, 2017**. Judge May, in accordance with Section 3, Article VI of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, has petitioned to be retained in office and to be renewed for an additional term. The Constitution of the State of Hawai'i empowers the Commission to determine whether Judge May should be retained in office for an additional term of six years.
