Pursuant to HRS § 103D -102 (b)(4) and HAR Chapter 3-120, The Judiciary requests a procurement exemption for the following:

1. Describe the goods, services or construction:

K6559, K6560, K6561. Clean and Sober Home is a house designed and operated to provide a stable environment of clean and sober living conditions to sustain recovery and that is shared by unrelated adults who:

- 1) Are recovering from substance abuse and share household expenses.
- 2) Do not require 24 hour supervision, rehabilitation, or therapeutic services on the premises.
- 3) Meet applicable laws, codes and rules of the counties and State.

Clean and sober housing for adults with serious mental illness and/or adults with serious mental illness who may also have co-occurring alcohol and other drug problems, to facilitate a stable transition through various stages of treatment.

A. Oxford House

B. Friends for Drug Court C. Po'ailani, Inc.

6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:

A. It is neither practical nor advantageous for the Judiciary to solicit other quotations for this particular service because these type of homes are limited in number throughout the Island of Oahu and for the most part, are operated by individuals in the recovery community. They are unique clean and sober houses in that they adhere to specific county & state zoning codes and each house is financially self-supporting. Each house member is expected to pay their equal share of the monthly expenses. Based on the the limited pool of providers to undergo the full procurement process is impractical.

B. Po'ailani is a program that specializes in treatment for adults with dual-disorders of substance abuse and mental health. They provide residential and intensive outpatient treatment and the clients are able to smoothly transition from residential treatment into outpatient treatment with Po'ailani's community based housing. Po'ailani Inc. offers a continuous and integrated approach of providing co-occurring treatment and housing services in a continuum of care that is community-based and consumer-focused. All of the residents have mental health issues so the housing staff is trained to assist them when crisis occurs.

7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:

A. The process for selecting the contractor is basically through the Oxford House Inc. since they have house standards that support substance abusing offenders in their rehabilitation process. The probation officers have been able to monitor the offender's progress with the collaborative effort of the Oxford House members.

B. The selection process was based on sole provider since Po'ailani Inc.'s housing is an extension of the treatment they provide for program participants. This provider offers a continuous and integrated approach of providing mental health and co-occurring treatment with housing services in a continuum of care for persons participating in Po'ailani's various treatment services that support the client's recovery process.
