ORDER AMENDING RULE 1 OF THE

RULES OF THE CIRCUIT COURTS OF THE STATE OF HAWAI I (By: Moon, C.J.; Levinson, Nakayama, Acoba, and Duffy, JJ.)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 1 of the Rules of the Circuit Courts of the State of Hawaii, is amended, effective July 01, 2005, as follows (deleted material is bracketed and stricken, new material is underlined):

Rule 1. CLASSIFICATION OF PROCEEDINGS.

All proceedings shall be divided into [nine] classes, viz.: CIVIL; CRIMINAL; <u>CONSERVATORSHIP; CONSERVATORSHIP-</u> <u>GUARDIANSHIP; SMALL CONSERVATORSHIP;</u> PROBATE; GUARDIANSHIP; SMALL ESTATE; SMALL GUARDIANSHIP; <u>TRUST;</u> SPECIAL PROCEEDINGS; MECHANIC'S AND MATERIALMAN'S LIEN; AND FAMILY COURT.

Proceedings in mandamus, habeas corpus, quo warranto, prohibition and any other proceedings not specifically included herein shall be classified under special proceedings.
