ORDER AMENDING RULES OF THE
SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF HAWAII
(By: Moon, C.J., Levinson, Nakayama, Acoba, and Duffy, JJ.)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 14.4(a) of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawaii is amended, effective July 1, 2007 as follows (deleted material is bracketed and stricken; new material is underscored):

14.4. Scope of practice.

A person licensed as a foreign law consultant under this rule may render legal services in the State of Hawaii, subject, however, to the limitations that such person shall not:

(a) appear for another person as attorney in any court or before any magistrate or other judicial officer in the State of Hawaii, or prepare pleadings or any other papers in any action or proceeding brought in any such court or before any such judicial officer, except as authorized in Rule [~~1(b)(1)~~] 1.9 relating to admission pro hac vice; or
