Rule 10. THE RECORD ON APPEAL.

* * *

- (b) The transcript of <u>court</u> proceedings.
- (1) REQUEST TO PREPARE TRANSCRIPT.
- (A) When to request. When an appellant desires to raise any point on appeal that requires consideration of the oral proceedings before the court [or agency] appealed from, the appellant shall file with the appellate clerk, within 10 days after filing the notice of appeal, a request or requests to prepare a reporter's transcript of such parts of the proceedings as the

appellant deems necessary that are not already on file. A request for transcripts of audiotapes or videotapes may list more than one tape on the request. The appellate clerk shall transmit the request(s) to prepare transcript to the designated reporter(s), the clerk of the court appealed from, and the supervising court reporter.
