IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 41 of the Hawai'i Rules of Penal Procedure is amended, effective July 1, 2013, as follows (deleted material is bracketed and stricken; new material is underscored):

Rule 41. SEARCH AND SEIZURE.

(a) Authority to issue warrant. Except as otherwise provided by statute, a [A] search warrant may be issued by any district or circuit judge (1) within the circuit wherein the property sought is located; or (2) within the circuit where the property is anticipated to be located. Application therefor should be made to a district judge wherever practicable.
