6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:

A Request for Proposal for Providing Guardian Ad Litem Services for the Family Court and Family Drug Court or Legal Counsel for Parents Services through Family Court during the period July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2015 was solicitated in March 2013. There were three proposals submitted for Guardian Ad Litem and four proposals submitted for Legal Counsel for Parents Services. The Legal Counsel for Parents Services was protested and the solicitation was canceled in regards to RFP J 14001. However, the children and other parties deemed appropriate by the Court in the HRS 587A proceedings are still in need of services.
