Pursuant to HRS § 103D -102 (b)(4) and HAR Chapter 3-120, The Judiciary requests a procurement exemption for the following:

1. Describe the goods, services or construction: (RQ#Y4442 Ewa, #Y4371 Kaneohe, #Y4370 Kauikeaouli)

Expand the First Circuit's security system by installing and providing additional security access control services to integrate the First Circuit access systems and consolidate that system on an existing blade at ITCD computer center. The Circuit has sufficient licenses to bring Ewa, Kaneohe and Kauikeaouli Hale into the system at no further cost to the Circuit through a previous IFB J13218. The hub of the existing system for Kapolei and Ka`ahumanu Hale is located at ITCD providing it with 24/7 emergency power. As noted in the attached letter, Security Resources is the only company in Hawaii authorized, certified and trained to install, service and maintain the Premysis software system already purchased through an IFB process. Public Safety is also in agreement that one consolidated system would improve security.

6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:

In a courthouse environment the need to provide immediate on-site response is critical to ensure proper security of our Judges, employees and the public. The previous IFB resulted in only one provider that could meet the response and servicing requirement of on-site emergency response within 4 hours and non emergency response of one business day. It does not make sense to go out again for the same result as this company is the only one that can meet that requirement as they are the only company in Hawaii authorized, certified and trained to install, service and maintain the Premysis software system. See attached letter. The First Circuit has placed the primary system for PremiSys at Kauikeaouli Hale, from which the Kapolei and Ka'ahumanu Hale court buildings are able to run their respective systems. This system has sufficient licenses to run all of the the buildings in the Frist Circuit which we already own. Extending site locations to Kauikeaouli Hale, Ewa and Kaneohe DC provides consistency and standardization of access control and security systems throughout the First Circuit in keeping with recommendations out of the 20/20 report. It Provides for standardization and consistency of security procedures for Judges, staff and sheriffs. Public Safety feels that such a consolidated system would improve their ability to gather forensic data on crimes and incidents in our buildings. To duplicate this system at additional expense is fiscally irresponsible. See attached for further information.

The original selection of this vendor was through IFB J13218. The exemption is being requested to complete the system for the First Circuit Court.
