RE: Seventh Amendment to Master Agreement for Contract J08165 (Vendor: WireVibe, LLC)

The State of Hawaii Judiciary entered into a Master Agreement with WireVibe, LLC (WireVibe) on October 27, 2007, to provide technical consulting services for the Judiciary Information Management System (JIMS) project. The services provided by WireVibe, over the past five years included support services for the Judiciary Bench Warrant project, testing and implementation of the Commercial Driver's License interface, support services for the Jury Phase 2 project, development and implementation of the Appellate module and Appellate e-Filing, and development of a project plan and functional and technical requirements for migrating data and functions into JIMS to support District Court criminal case processing. The Sixth Amendment to the Master Agreement will expire on October 31, 2012.

Pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 3-120-5, JIMS is requesting your approval to extend Wirevibe's contract and amend the contract as an exemption from Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 103D. The contract duration will be for one month and will expire on November 30, 2012. The request for the exemption is based on the delay incurred by the unsuccessful solicitor's protest to the award of the Request for Proposal J12282 and the disruption of the transition plans with the new vendor.

The cost of this extension will be \$30,000.00 and funds are available through appropriation code S-13-315-J-8055. If you have any questions, please call me at 538-5308.
