ORDER CONCERNING COMPUTATION OF TIME

In consideration of an October 5, 2011 equipment failure that disabled the Judiciary Electronic Filing and Service System (JEFS) and thereby prevented the electronic filing of documents in the appellate courts,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that October 5, 2011, October 6, 2011, October 7, 2011, and each consecutive business day during which JEFS is unavailable for 4 hours or more between the hours of 7:45 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., shall be treated, for purposes of computing time under Rule 26 of the Hawai'i Rules of Appellate Procedure, HRS § 1-29, and other similar statutes and rules, as a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday.
