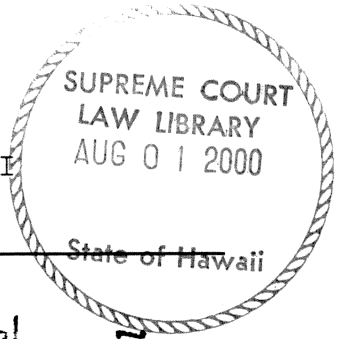

ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE ITEMS DUE TO  
BE FILED ON JULY 31, 2000  
IN THE SECOND JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

In consideration of the closing of all courts in the Second Judicial Circuit due to Tropical Storm Daniel, and under the authority of Hawai'i Revised Statutes § 602-4 and article VI, § 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due to be filed in the Second Judicial Circuit on July 31, 2000, is extended by one day to August 1, 2000. In other words, all documents due to have been filed on Monday, July 31, 2000 shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by close of business on Tuesday, August 1, 2000.
