ORDER ASSIGNING JUDGES OF THE INTERMEDIATE
COURT OF APPEALS OF THE STATE OF HAWAII TO SERVE
TEMPORARILY, ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS,
ON THE SUPREME COURT OF HAWAII
FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING RULE AMENDMENTS

Pursuant to article VI, section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, I, RONALD T. Y. MOON, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby assign the Chief Judge and Associate Judges of the Intermediate Court of Appeals of the State of Hawai'i to serve temporarily and individually, on the Supreme Court of Hawai'i, on an as needed basis, for the purpose of considering amendments to the rules of court, whenever any justice, including the Chief Justice, is unavailable.

This designation shall also apply to any individual who may hereinafter be appointed and qualified as chief judge or associate judge of the Intermediate Court of Appeals and shall be effective immediately upon his or her signing of the oath of office.
