the opening brief; (4) on April 27, 2011, the appellate clerk mailed a notice to Appellant informing him that: (a) the time to file the statement of jurisdiction and the opening brief expired; (b) the matter would be brought to the attention of the court on May 9, 2011 for such action as the court deems proper; and (c) the appeal may be dismissed pursuant to Hawai'i Rules of Appellate Procedure (HRAP) Rule 30; (5) the notice, which was sent to Appellant's last known address, was returned with a notation that it was undeliverable and that the post office was unable to forward it; and (6) apart from filing the notice of appeal, Appellant has taken no other steps to prosecute his appeal, and he has not provided the court with a current mailing address. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeal is dismissed pursuant to HRAP Rule 30.
