Echineque (Petitioner) on March 08, 2012 in this court, the papers in support, and the records and files herein, it appears that: (1) Petitioner has a Hawaii Rules of Penal Procedure (HRPP) Rule 40 petition for post-conviction relief pending in the Circuit Court of the First Circuit (circuit court), Echineque v.
