SUMMARY DISPOSITION ORDER (By: Foley, Presiding J., Fujise and Reifurth, JJ.)

Plaintiffs-Appellants Tara Thomas, Donna Thomas, and Jack Thomas (Appellants) appeal the December 30, 2009 Judgment of the Circuit Court of the First Circuit¹ (circuit court) dismissing Appellants' complaint.

On appeal, Appellants contend their complaint properly pled claims for abuse of process and harassment.

Upon careful review of the record and the briefs submitted by the parties and having given due consideration to the arguments advanced and the issues raised by the parties, as

well as the relevant statutory and case law, we conclude Appellants' appeal is without merit.

The filing of a garnishment proceeding to collect on a judgment is not a willful act in the use of a process which is not proper in the regular conduct of the proceeding, and thus, not an abuse of process. Young v. Allstate Ins. Co., 119 Haw. 403, 412, 198 P.3d 666, 675 (2008). Additionally, an alleged misrepresentation of case authority in circuit court is not an abuse of process. As well, the filing of a fraudulent conveyance case in circuit court is not an abuse of process claims and therefore is equally without merit.

Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the December 30, 2009 Judgment of the Circuit Court of the First Circuit is affirmed. DATED: Honolulu, Hawaiʻi, March 6, 2012.
