- (1) on August 23, 2013, Claimant-Appellant Pamela J. Almodova, pro se (Appellant) filed a notice of appeal;

(c) the appeal may be dismissed; and


(5) thereafter, Appellant did not file the opening brief or respond to the notice of default. Therefore,
