ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI (By: Recktenwald, C.J., Nakayama, Acoba, and Duffy, JJ., and Circuit Judge Border, in place of McKenna, J., recused)

Petitioner/plaintiff-appellant Keith Murauskas filed an application for a writ of certiorari to review of the Intermediate Court of Appeals' (ICA) dismissal of petitioner's appeal for lack of appellate jurisdiction. The time for filing an application for a writ of certiorari commenced upon the filing of the ICA's September 15, 2011 order of dismissal, not the ICA's October 6, 2011 order denying reconsideration of the dismissal. <u>See</u> HRS § 602-59(c) (Supp. 2010) ("An application for a writ of certiorari may be filed in the supreme court no later than ninety days after the filing of the judgment or <u>dismissal order</u> of the intermediate appellate court.") (underscoring added). Petitioner's application for a writ of certiorari -- deemed filed on January 2, 2012 when it was delivered to prison officials for mailing -- was filed more than ninety days after the filing of the September 15, 2011 order of dismissal. The application is untimely. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application for a writ of certiorari is dismissed.
