6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:

Procurement has been completed by competitive means. A Request for Proposal (RFP) No. J16002 was issued in December 2014, for GAL and Legal Counsel (LC) services for the Family Court, Second Circuit during the period 07/01/2015 - 06/30/2017, with the ability to extend from 07/01/2017 - 06/30/2019. In response to this RFP, contracts were to be awarded to five attorneys and one licensed social worker. However, only four contracts were executed to provide the services mandated under the Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Chapter 587A. Of the four contractors, only three are willing to cover the islands of Lanai and Molokai. No other inquiries or proposals were submitted in response to RFP J16002. Also, the Court Appointed Special Advocate training, an RFP requirement, which needs to be completed in order to provide contracted GAL/LC services, begins in May 2016. As such, possible contractors for GAL/LC services will not be able to provide services for approximately six to twelve months after that period. Therefore, it is not practicable or advantageous to procure for this service by competitive means. It is felt that we need to procure additional contracted GAL/LC services as soon as possible to ensure quality mandated services are provided to parents and children in need of protection as the current contractors are overwhelmed with the number of cases they are being assigned. The contractors either meet the minimum qualifications as required by RFP J16002, are currently providing legal counsel services, and have agreed to provide services under a contract.

7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:

Contractors either meet the minimum qualifications as required by RFP J16002 or have been providing legal counsel services, and are willing to contract to provide GAL and LC services for the Second Circuit until such time as an RFP is issued. Additionally, contractors who have been providing services for HRS 587A without a contract are willing to continue to do so, however, would like the support and a more consistent form of compensation that they would receive with a contract.
