In consideration of the closing of the Kaneohe Courthouse (Abner Paki Hale) in the District Court of the First Circuit, due to necessary air conditioning system repair work, and, under the authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 602-4 and article VI, § 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due on Friday, December 9, 2016, Monday, December 12, 2016, and Tuesday, December 13, 2016 is extended to Wednesday, December 14, 2016. All documents due to have been filed in the Kaneohe District Court on the dates the courthouse is closed, shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by the close of business on Wednesday, December 14, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of Abner Paki Hale, shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates, with the following exception:

This closure will not affect summary possession return hearings. All summary possession return hearings in civil regular claims ("RC") cases, with a return date of Friday, December 9, 2016, will still be held as scheduled at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom A in the Kaneohe District Court.
