DRIVER'S LICENSE REVOCATION

FOR OVUII ARREST (DRUGS)**

NOAR = Notice of Administrative Revocation issued by police officer to respondent at time of arrest.

IIP = Ignition Interlock Permit; authorizes respondent to drive during revocation period with ignition interlock device installed in vehicle (if eligible).

EDP = Employee Driver's Permit; for employer-owned vehicle (if eligible).

Hearing requested w/in 6 days after Review Decision is scheduled w/in 39 days of arrest/NOAR.

Hearing requested later than 6 days after Review Decision, but within 60 days of arrest/NOAR, is scheduled w/in 30 days of hearing request. No right to hearing if requested later than 60 days after arrest/NOAR.
