
Upon consideration of pro se Claimant-Appellant Kenneth M. Skahan's (Appellant) March 17, 2017 "Motion for Reconsideration of the Order Dismissing the Appeal Dated March 14, 2017," the papers in support, and the record, it appears that (1) on March 14, 2017, the court dismissed the appeal for failure to pay the appellate filing and docketing fees, which were due on or before January 23, 2017; (2) Appellant seeks reconsideration of the dismissal order because on March 8, 2017, he mailed payment to the Labor and Industrial Relations

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the Labor and Industrial Relations Appeals Board shall file the record on appeal within thirty days from the date of this order.


