Provide Legal counsel services for indigent parents and young adults participating in the Voluntary Foster Care program under HRS Chapter 346, Part XIX (Young Adult Voluntary Foster Care Program), Guardian Ad Litem (GAL) services for parties in HRS Chapter 587A, and GAL services for children in HRS Chapter 571 proceedings.

6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:

Procurement has been completed by competitive means. A Request for Proposal (RFP) No. J16002 was issued in December 2014, for GAL and Legal Counsel (LC) services for the Family Court, Second Circuit during the period 07/01/2015 - 06/30/2017, with the ability to extend from 07/01/2017 - 06/30/2019. In response to this RFP, contracts were to be awarded to five (5) attorneys and one (1) licensed social worker. However, only four (4) contracts were executed to provide the services mandated under the Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Chapter 587A. Of the four (4) contractors, only three (3) are willing to cover the islands of Lanai and Molokai. No other inquiries or proposals were submitted in response to RFP J16002. It is not practical or advantageous to procure for this service by competitive means as there were no other proposals submitted for RFP J16002 when procurement was initially solicited. As such, to ensure quality mandated services are provided to parents who qualify for legal counsel and children who are in need of protection, it is felt that we need additional contracted GAL and LC services.

7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:

The contractor either meets the minimum qualifications as required by RFP J16002 or has been providing legal counsel services, and is willing to contract to provide GAL and LC services for the Second Circuit until such time as an RFP is issued. Contractor has the knowledge of the existing Judiciary procedures and is knowledgeable of what the Judiciary requires.
