Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: Treatment services for sexually reactive children/youth and their families are needed in two geographical locations (First Judicial Circuit - Oahu) and (Third Judicial Circuit - Island of Hawaii). These clinical, therapeutic treatment services requires one provider to ensure quality assurance and consistency in delivery. Treatment of sexually reactive children/youth, especially during an investigative crisis period, are highly specialized with limited qualified providers available. Catholic Charities Hawaii (CCH) has provided these services on Oahu and Hawaii island. A new contract with this Provider will enable essential services to continue. Catholic Charities Hawaii (CCH) has been the provider of this services for many years via an RFP process. During this prior procurement, no other provider demonstrated capacity to serve clients on both Oahu and Hawaii Island. CCH has established programs with specialized skills and expertise to serve this required population on Oahu and Hawaii Island.</p>

Describe the reason for the selection of the provider including a description of how the procedure, as much as practicable, ensured maximum fair and open competition: Catholic Charities Hawaii (CCH) has been the provider of this services for many years via an RFP process. During this prior procurement, no other provider demonstrated capacity to serve clients on both Oahu and Hawaii Island. CCH has established programs with specialized skills and expertise to serve this required population on Oahu and Hawaii Island.</p>
