By letters dated May 8, 2018, the State of Hawai‘i Elections Commission notified Chief Justice Recktenwald of the need to appoint two individuals from Kauai County as members of the commission, under the authority conferred by Hawai‘i Revised Statutes Section 11-7(c), and in the absence of a Senate Minority Leader, Applications from the public were sought on May 17, 2018, with the deadline extended on May 31, 2018, and having considered the applicants for the vacancy,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Hawai'i Revised Statutes § 11-7(c), that **CAROL E. SEIELSTAD** is appointed as a commissioner on the Hawai'i Elections Commission, in place of Patricia Berg, effective immediately upon the filing of this order and expiring on June 30, 2022.
