OR TO CONDUCT HEARINGS REQUIRED TO BE HELD ON
AUGUST 23, 2018 AND AUGUST 24, 2018, IN THE APPELLATE,
CIRCUIT, DISTRICT AND DISTRICT FAMILY COURTS
OF THE FIRST AND FIFTH CIRCUITS

In consideration of the closing of all of the Courts in
the First and Fifth Circuits due to the anticipation of severe
weather conditions brought on by Hurricane Lane, and, under the
authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 601-2 and § 602-3, and
article VI, § 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due
on Thursday, August 23, 2018 and Friday, August 24, 2018, in all
the Courts in the First Circuit - City and County of Honolulu,
and in the Fifth Circuit - County of Kauai, is extended to

Monday, August 27, 2018. All documents due to have been filed shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by the close of business on Monday, August 27, 2018.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of all the Courts in the First Circuit - City and County of Honolulu, and in the Fifth Circuit - County of Kauai, shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
