Upon consideration of petitioners' application for writ of certiorari or in the alternative petition for writ of mandamus, filed on September 5, 2018, respondent's response to the application for writ of certiorari, filed on October 3, 2018, the respective supporting documents, and the record, it appears that petitioner is seeking certiorari review of the Intermediate Court of Appeals' August 15, 2018 order granting in part the motions for stay and the September 4, 2018 order denying the motion for reconsideration or, in the alternative, a writ of mandamus. 2. As to the request for mandamus relief:

a. Within twenty (20) days from the date of this order, the respondent shall file an answer to the petition.

b. The appellate clerk shall serve a copy of this order upon the respondent as required by HRAP Rule 21(c).
