Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: It is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means because Honeywell furnished and installed all of the original fire alarm and surveillance system at Lahaina District Court. The primary operating system (hardware and software) was manufactured by Honeywell, and they have the only certified technicians that are factory trained to exclusively work on this system. Honeywell holds proprietary rights to any software upgrades. As such, original manufacture has the most expertise of the system and would provide the best quality of service to The Judiciary.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Contractor/vendor had been selected in a prior Administration. Selection of Honeywell as the contractor to maintain the system at Lahaina District Court is based on several factors. The system is primarily a Honeywell operating system, they have the expertise and experience in maintaining the system, and any upgrades can only be provided by them. Vendors' technicians are factory trained to exclusively work on the existing system.</p>
