FTR installations in Hilo are at the end of their support lives. Addressing one issue initiates a cascade of compatibility complications. There is material probability that maintaining FTR functionality will require replacing entire systems. The Third Circuit owns FTR in Hilo courtrooms and JAVS in West Hawaii courtrooms. Due to our experiences with both					
systems, we believe a JAVS system will be more reliable, and less costly to maintain. These are important considerations for courts of record, and for stewardship of public resources.					
7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:					
We have experience owning both FTR and JAVS systems. FTR requires owner involvement in system maintenance, like removing components and sending them to manufacturers for repair. JAVS sends their technician to the court to do repairs.
