As such, original manufacturer has the most expertise of the system and would provide the best quality of service to The Judiciary.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Contractor /vendor had been selected in a prior administration. Selection of Johnson Controls as the contractor to maintain the equipment at Hoapili Hale is based on a couple factors. The equipment is a part of a Johnson Controls system and they have the expertise and experience in maintaining the proprietary systems.</p>
