Pursuant to HRS § 103D -102 (b)(4) and HAR Chapter 3-120, The Judiciary requests a procurement exemption for the following:

<p>1. Describe the goods, services or construction:</p> <p>Consulting services for the Judiciary's public communication needs and for dealing with media inquiries.</p>

<p>6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: It is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means because this request is to extend the current contract with TMB Consulting Corp. as an exemption from Hawaii Revised Statutes chapter 103D. Tammy Mori Brownfield is the former Special Assistant for Judiciary Communications and is therefore very knowledgeable about Judiciary communications needs. In addition, she has special expertise in video/electronic communications, which is an area of increasing need to advance Judiciary communications. Currently, the Communications & Community Relations (CCR) staff of three is at capacity with day-to-day operations. Only the director's position is exempt, leaving very little flexibility to accommodate additional workload. Also, one of the two staff members is currently on Family Medical Leave and at times not available to work, with little advance notice. TMB Consulting can provide immediate assistance and augment services and production by the CCR Department.</p> <p>The term of this Agreement (attached) shall commence upon execution of the Agreement by both parties and end on May 31, 2020. This is a labor hour contract. TMB Consulting Corp. shall be paid at the rate of \$65 per hour. The total amount of compensation to be paid to TMB Consulting Corp. shall not exceed \$15,000 inclusive of taxes. TMB Consulting will submit a written invoice for each month in which services are provided.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Consideration was given to professionals who are familiar with Judiciary operations. Due to the unexpected need for the services, consideration also was given to persons who are immediately available to provide the services, and who can continue providing services when called upon. As the former Special Assistant for Judiciary Communications, Ms. Mori is extremely knowledgeable about the Judiciary and she is available to provide the services as soon as needed. She is also available to assist the current Special Assistant during the staff shortage.</p>
