It will not be practicable or advantageous for the Program/Division to procure this by competitive or other means because the Judiciary is in the midst of converting the Civil case types from the Judiciary mainframe HAJIS system. This vendor Capgemini America has already converted 75% of the mainframe cases and expanded the Judiciary Information Management Systems (JIMS) to manage these civil cases. With the remaining cases to be converted out of mainframe being Family Court Civil cases, it would be in the best interest of the Judiciary to remain with the vendor to complete this final conversion as expeditiously as possible in order to decommission of the mainframe, which is currently costing the Judiciary about \$500K a year to lease, whilst providing maintenance and enhancements to the existing JIMS system.
