The goals are to establish a statewide program that permits the posting of monetary bail twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week for defendants for whom a monetary amount of bail has been set by the police, other law enforcement agency, court, or are in the custody of the Department of Public Safety.

As part of its planning process, The Judiciary is seeking comments, input, and information from current and prospective contractors and the community to ensure that the RFP will address the service needs of Act 179 while complying with program policies and procedures established pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes 804. This RFI is especially interested in the following:

- How much is a fair service delivery price
- What procedures may hinder someone to bail out
- What are some of the problems with 24/7 monetary bail
- How would the structure look like with 24/7 bail
- What are the benefits of 24/7 bail
