ORDER DESIGNATING JUDGE TO CONSIDER APPLICATIONS
FOR ELECTRONIC EAVESDROPPING IN THE STATE OF HAWAI‘I
(By: Recktenwald, C.J.)

Pursuant to Part IV of chapter 803 of the Hawai‘i Revised Statutes (HRS) (1993), I hereby designate the **Honorable Henry T. Nakamoto** to hear applications in the Third Circuit (County of Hawai‘i) for a court order authorizing or approving:

- (1) the interception of wire, oral or electronic communications (HRS § 803-44);
- (2) the installation and use of a pen register or a trap and trace device (HRS §§ 803-44.5 and 803-44.6); and
- (3) the installation and use of a mobile tracking device (HRS § 803-44.7).

This designation shall take effect on November 29, 2019, and remain in effect until further ordered.
