In the event that Defendant's treating physician determines that transport to the hearing set on _____ would present a risk of danger to Defendant or to others, or if the Defendant chooses to waive his/her physical presence at the hearing, Defendant's presence at the hearing may be by way of Video-Conferencing or waived.
