Representatives of the Department of Law Enforcement, Sheriff's Division designate shall transport the Defendant from _____ to the above-entitled Court for a further hearing on _____ at _____ .m., and shall remain with the Defendant until the conclusion of the hearing, at which time Defendant may or may not be transported back to the facility deemed appropriate by the Director of Health ("DOH Facility").

In the event that Defendant's treating physician determines that transport to the hearing would present a risk of danger to Defendant or to others, or if the Defendant chooses to waive his/her physical presence at the hearing, Defendant's presence at the hearing may be by way of Video-Conferencing.

Representatives of the Department of Law Enforcement, Sheriff's Division designate shall transport the Defendant from the DOH Facility to this Court, and back to said facility, for any further hearings as ordered by this Court.
