Plan for Your Safety Plan ñan kejbarok iok

A temporary restraining order (TRO), order for protection, or injunction cannot guarantee your safety. Plan very carefully for your safety and the safety of your loved ones.

Juõn temporary restraining order (TRO), ortar ñan kejbarok, ak kibel jen court ejab maroñ lukun kejbarok eok ak bobrae an wor joreen ko nan kwe.. Koman am plan ko relukun tiljek ñan kejbarok eok im ro kwoj yokwe er.

Here are some safety tips:

Erkein jet ian wawin kejbarok ko:

- Tell everyone you know that you have a TRO, order for protection, or injunction (your employer, church leader, friends, family and baby-sitter, etc.).
Jiroñ aoleb bwe eor am TRO, ortar ñan kejbarok, ak ortar jen court (ijo kwoj jermal ie, ri-tel ro an kabuñ, ro jeram, baamle im ri-kajiriri eo, im ro jet.).
- Change the locks on your doors and windows as soon as possible. Replace wooden doors with steel doors. Jeniji lak in kojem ko im winto ko am ilo ien eo emokaj tata. Jolok kejem alal ko im kelaak kejem mää ko.
- Install security systems if possible. Purchase additional locks, window bars, poles to wedge against doors. Kolaak security system ko elane komaron. . Bar wia lock bwe en loñlok, bar ñan winto ko, pole ko ñan kejem ko..
- Install smoke detectors and keep fire extinguishers on every floor. You never know what your abuser might do.
Kōlaak smoke detector (men ko rej eñjake an batat im jañ) im ilik kein ikkun ko ilo aoleb floor ko. Kojjab jela ta eo ri-kakure eo emaroñ komane.
- Install extra outside lighting — include motion-activated lighting.
Kōlaak elōñlok teñki ko inaboj — ekoba light ko rej make ebbol ñe ej wor armij ej makitkit turier.
- Teach your children their name, address, phone number, the phone number of a friend/relative and how to dial 911 in case they are kidnapped by your abuser.
Katakin ajri ro nejum etaier, atreej eo air, telpoon nōmba, telpoon nomba an eo jeram/nukum im kilen aer dial 911 bwe ne ri kokkure eo ebaj koote ir.
- Make sure everyone who watches your children is informed of who is authorized to pick up your children. Lukun lale bwe ro rej lale ajri ro nejum ren jelā won ro eor aer melim in bok ajri ro nejum.
- Inform your baby-sitters of your situation. They have the right to know so they will be better prepared to protect the children in their care.
Karoñ ri-kajiriri eo am kin problem eo am. Eor air jimwe in jela bwe ren maroñ bojak im jela wewin kojbarok ajiri ro ilo ien aer lale er.

Keep a copy of your TRO, order for protection, or injunction with you at all times and report violations to the police immediately.
